

Dear Cape Island Resort Seasonals,

We hope this note finds you and family well during this extremely tumultuous time. In this letter, we hope to outline when we plan to open the park and how we plan to subsequently operate, in lieu of the CO-VID 19 outbreak. Please keep in mind as you read the following, that this situation is extremely fluid and can change day to day or even hour to hour. Also, please be aware that Cape Island Resort is fully committed to opening and operating the park in complete compliance within the guidelines that the county and state require. (Attached you will find the county's synopsis and recommendation for all Cape May County Campgrounds)

Accordingly, Cape Island Resort will now open on **Monday May 11th 2020 at 9:00 AM**. Due to this delay, Cape Island will also be extending the rent due date to **Friday May 1st**. And finally, we will be **WAIVING** all late fees for the 2020 season. (Please note though, you **WILL NOT** have access to the park until your rent is paid in full.)

It is imperative that you view the park's opening as an extension of your current residence- therefore, please plan to exist in a **FULLY QUARANTINED STATE** (at your own trailer), until we are directed otherwise by the proper authority.

The following parameters will be in place upon your arrival and will exist indefinitely:

- **The OFFICE*, SNACK BAR, GAME ROOM and POOLS will all be CLOSED Indefinitely**
- **NO Campfires**
- **NO Outside Contractors (with the exception of Comcast & AC Electric)**
- **NO Visitors ****
- **NO Gatherings (Public or Private)**
- **NO Activities**
- **NO Playgrounds**
- **NO UNSUPERVISED children**
- **LIMITED Public Restrooms and Laundry Facilities (at your own risk)**
- **LIMITED Trash Service at 10 AM & 3 PM (House trash & recycling ONLY- no bulk items due to the Office Closure)**

Due to the Office being closed, please bring a vehicle to Cape Island that already has a sticker on it, and is registered and paid for the 2020 season. If you have concerns, please E-MAIL Cape Island Resort (capeislandresort@gmail.com) in the coming weeks to come up with a solution **PRIOR to May 11th.*

*** In addition to no visitors, we ask that **ONLY** the owners of the unit enter Cape Island.*

For 44 seasons, Cape Island Resort has put the safety and security of their employees and residents first and foremost. This is especially true during this difficult time, where it is imperative for everyone to **FULLY** adhere to the above stipulations. We cannot stress enough, that a trip to Cape Island should not be viewed as "normal," for the time being. This means, please be mindful of your personal health (if you do not feel well, **PLEASE** stay at your primary residence) and limit the number of non-essential family members you have in your trailer.

FAILURE TO COMPLY TO THE ABOVE RULES WILL RESULT IN THE PARK BEING CLOSED IMMEDIATELY.

Thank you in advance for your patience and complete cooperation, and we look forward to returning to a sense of normalcy.
